Trying To Conceive & Infertility

For many women, experiencing challenges with infertility or losing a pregnancy can cause shame, self-blame, and feelings of inadequacy (Wenzel, 2020).

Analysis

- Linguistic Inquiry and Word Count (LIWC) (Pennebaker et al., 2015)
- Series of statistical analyses were performed, including Welch's T-Test

Results

- Women who experienced a pregnancy loss:
 - ↑ first-person pronouns
 - † positive and negative emotion words
 - ↑ social words
 - ↓ cognitive processing words

Discussion

- Emotional upheaval
- Desire for social support
- · Struggle to make sense of grief

Limitations

Big data → significant results
